Eatontown, N.J. - DSCI announced today that it has been awarded a five-year contract from the US Army's Communications Electronics Life Cycle Management Command (CELCMC) under the U.S. Army's World Wide Satellite Systems (WWSS) Program. DSCI is one of six prime contractors selected to provide integrated capabilities to satisfy global requirements for state-of-the-art turn-key satellite systems for Department of Defense and all other federal agencies. The contract, with a total program value of \$5 billion, also includes the associated engineering and support services
